5. ARRIVAL INFORMATION

■ The overwhelming majority of people are arriving throughout the day on Friday and departing Sunday. A small number are planning to attend only Saturday.

- **On-Campus Housing – Late Arrival to Campus.** If you arrive Friday evening after the 6:00 pm closure of the University Registration Desk, you can pick up your room key at the Housing Desk at Campus Square Building D lounge (these are the apartments that run along Morton St.- in the area of the new bookstore), and is the building closest to the Whitaker Lab parking lot.
- **No University-Sponsored Activities and Not Staying On Campus.** If you are neither attending a University-sponsored activity (the parade excluded) nor staying in on-campus housing, you are not required to register with the University and consequently you do not need to stop by the University Alumni Weekend Registration Desk. Registration is not required for the parade.

9. REUNION PARADE – SATURDAY, MAY 18,

➤ **Meet at Flagpole in front of University Center at 2:15 pm**

➤ **Official Parade starts at 2:30 pm**

- An essential part of the weekend is the Sig-Ep participation in the Annual Reunion Parade. We will be the first non 5-year-class group to ever march as an affinity group in the Parade.

For those who want a more sedate atmosphere than the No Name, this would likely be the place.
