2. WEEKEND ATTIRE

- Casual throughout the weekend (ties & jackets will be confiscated / jackets are 'permitted' at ReunionFest)
- Shorts, jeans, etc. will generally work all weekend
- Friday Night ReunionFest – Pick-em' – Most common will be business casual; with crowd ranging from shorts/jeans to slacks & blazers (fewer folks on the dressy end)
- Evenings – Friday Reunion Fest and Saturday Evening Party at Sig-Ep House will be outdoors (tented). Depending on the weather forecast, bring along a light jacket or sweater
- Friday & Saturday Lunches – casual, Irish-sports bar type locales
- Saturday Morning Historic Parade of Classes – shorts/jeans - Sig-Ep Reunion T-shirt Required
 - Hint #1 – White or Khaki will go well with T-shirt chosen by your committee this year, jeans will work

If you are neither attending the ReunionFest (or other University-sponsored activity) nor staying in on-campus housing, you are not required to register with the University and consequently you do not need to stop by the University Alumni Weekend Registration Desk. Registration is not required for the Parade of Classes.
